- Sled width and height restriction 7 feet. No weight or length restrictions.
- 7. Each rider is allowed 1 run down the hill.
- 8. One sled entry per individuals individuals cannot ride on more than 1 sled.
- 9. No overnight camping. You must arrive at the set time as instructed by NOW! staff.

- 10. Alcohol is not permitted in the race. Sled contestants may not drink alcohol prior to racing.
- 11. Any inappropriate behavior, as deemed by NOW! staff, will result in disqualification this includes drinking, smoking, throwing snowballs, etc.
- 12. All prizes will be presented to winners at Jim Pattison Broadcast Group Edmonton's office, unless otherwise noted.
- 13. Inability of winners to accept the prizes will result in forfeiture. Certain prizes may require winner to be 18 years of age or older, or have signed permission of parent or legal guardian to accept the prize.
